Quick Response Grants

Public and private schools may apply for small grants up to \$500. Requests will be accepted on a rolling basis beginning September 1, 2009 through April 13, 2010. One page summaries may be submitted by the first of each month. A response will be given fifteen days following the submission deadline. Grants are to fund classroom projects. Requests to fund transportation, food or field trips will not be considered. A one page summary should include the following information:

1. Who are you?
2. Project summary: Where do you want to go? What need will this meet? Who will benefit from this project?
3. Project specifics: How will you get there? What is your implementation plan? What is your project budget (Please include a detailed budget)? How will this project be sustained after the project is complete?
4. Project outcomes: How will you know you have arrived? What outcomes do you anticipate? How will you collect the data? How will you measure outcomes?
5. Project communication: How will you spread the word? How will you recognize the Education Foundation of Indian River County?
